



## Barb Rosenstock – VIRTUAL VISITS

When students meet an author, there's authentic excitement about books, writing and research. Questions bounce around the room, books get read, kids WANT to write! Even though it's best to be together, much of the same interactivity and learning can occur with a virtual author visit. For this challenging 2020-21 school year, Barb will offer online school visits for grades K through 5, tailored to your school's needs.

**Pricing:** All sessions are 45 minutes unless indicated. Presentations or writing workshops can be scheduled as single sessions or combined as part of a full day at a school/district. Single session: \$400. Full day: \$1000 (3 sessions.)

### Presentations

**Adventures in Writing True Stories.** An introduction to the real-life writing process from author Barb Rosenstock. This covers the steps from idea through publication, tells the stories behind a number of Barb's books and helps students discover how to handle writing's frustrations and joys.

**Down, Down Into the Deep—STEM Writing!** A deep dive into writing a nonfiction science story. Students learn about the research process behind *Otis & Will Discover the Deep*. They'll participate in an ocean experiment, learn about STEM concepts and discover how writers are explorers too!

**Book Read Aloud plus Q & A** Barb will read aloud one of her books, followed by a 15-minute Q & A with students. \$150 (due to copyright restrictions, no distribution is allowed)

### Writing Workshops

**Noisy Writing: Working with Details!** Through some examples from the Caldecott Honor book *The Noisy Paint Box* as well as other picture books, we'll learn what details are, when we add them and a variety of ways to discover the details that will help your students' writing sing.

**Noisy Writing: Playing with Words!** A workshop all about figurative language: when we use it, why and how. We'll go over real life examples of the "Big 6" types of figurative language: imagery, onomatopoeia, alliteration, simile, personification and hyperbole. Real writers PLAY with words!
